## DD-IX Dresden Internet Exchange e.V. Code of Conduct

- Respectful Conduct: We value a respectful and polite tone of communication. Discrimination, harassment, insults, or any other forms of derogatory behavior are not permitted.
- Open and Inclusive Community: We welcome and appreciate the diversity of our members. Everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, ethnicity or religion, is welcome and should feel comfortable and safe in our community.
- Collaboration and Support: We foster a culture of collaboration and mutual respect. Members should support each other and contribute to the development of the community.
- 4. **No Harassment:** We condemn any form of harassment, including verbal, non-verbal, or sexual harassment. Everyone should feel safe to express their opinions without fear of retaliation.
- Confidentiality and Privacy: Members should respect the privacy and confidentiality
  of others. Personal information should only be shared with explicit consent from the
  individuals concerned.
- 6. **Responsible Conduct:** Each member is responsible for their own behavior. This includes compliance with laws, policies, and regulations, as well as avoiding actions that could harm the reputation of the association.
- 7. **Constructive Communication:** Discussions should be constructive and solution-oriented. Respectful exchange of ideas and viewpoints is encouraged, while personal attacks and insults are discouraged.
- 8. **Compliance with Rules:** Members are obligated to adhere to the rules and regulations of the association. Appropriate measures will be taken in case of violations to protect the integrity of the community.
- 9. **Conflict of Interest:** Members of the Board shall disclose any conflicts of interest and to abstain from voting. A conflict of interest also exists if there are significant dependencies to third parties, e.g. if a member of the Board receives more than 50% of his income from the third party or holds a share of more than 25% in the third party.
